## Friday, May 4<sup>th</sup>

## Saturday, May 5<sup>th</sup>

- Morning: Madison has 8 museum/houses, 8 antique shops/malls and several wineries. On Saturday you will have a choice of 2 options.
1. You can explore the town on your own. Most of the restored buildings allow self-guided tours at a modest charge.
  2. There will be a tour of the town planned by the visitors bureau. This will include 4 of the houses/museums (2 in the morning and 2 in the afternoon).
- Saturday's visitors bureau planned tour will be as follows:
- 9:00 AM Tour of the Lanier Mansion, 601 W. First Street. Approximately 1 hour. We will be divided into 2 groups; one watching a 10 minute video while the other begins the tour. When the video is over that group will start the tour. The first group will also see the video. Both groups will finish at the same time.
- 10:30 AM Tour the History Center and Railroad Museum, 615 W First Street. 1 hour.
- 12:00 Noon Lunch from 12 to 2 at Harry's Stone Grill, 621 Clifty Dr. Order off the menu and pay individually.
- 2:00 PM Tour the Saddletree Factory, 106 Milton Street. The group will be divided but everyone will finish at the same time. 1 hour
- 3:15 PM Tour the Costigan House, 408 W. Third Street. 1 hour.
- Evening Saturday evening we will have our banquet at the Clifty Inn with a silent auction and show and tell. See the Registration Form for meal choices. The Saturday evening speaker to be announced.
